

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING MAY 7, 2018 (FY18)

The Special Town Meeting was called to order at 7:53 p.m. There were 232 voters checked off on the voting list, constituting the quorum requirement of 150 voters. Town Clerk, Dawn M. Varley read the warrant and the meeting voted as follows:

Article 1

The Town voted IN THE MAJORITY to accept Section 17C of MGL Chapter 90, as provided for in the Municipal Relief Act, authorizing the Board of Selectmen to establish a speed limit of 25 miles per hour on any roadway inside thickly settled or business district, or take any other action relative thereto.

Proposed by the Town Administrator

Article 2

The Town voted UNANIMOUSLY the motion That \$280,000 is appropriated to pay costs for the purchase of existing streetlights from National Grid and the conversion of existing streetlights to energy efficient and long lasting LED, including the payment of all costs incidental and related thereto, and that to meet this appropriation, the Treasurer, with the approval of the Selectmen, is authorized to borrow said amount under and pursuant to Chapter 44, of the General Laws, or pursuant to any other enabling authority, and to issue bonds or notes of the Town therefor.

Proposed by the Town Administrator

Finance Committee voted 7-0-1 to recommend.

Article 3

The Town voted UNANIMOUSLY to appropriate 323,144.58 from Sewer-Water retained earnings to pay debt authorized by Article 2 of the December 11, 2017 Special Town Meeting, or take any other action relative thereto.

Proposed by the Town Administrator

Finance Committee voted 7-0-1 to recommend.

Article 4

The Town voted UNANIMOUSLY as AMENDED to transfer \$175.00 from Line 93A-Custodial Services of Article 2 of the May 1, 2017 Annual Town Meeting to fund a longevity payment for Fiscal Year 2016, or take any other action relative thereto.

Proposed by the Town Administrator

Finance Committee voted 7-0-1 to recommend.

Article 5


