CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES COMPLETED THIS WEEK:

1. C. Naughton had one crew continue the installation of the 20-inch HDPE sewer force main in the cross-country easement through the Thatcher Street Landfill this past week. Approximately 249 ft of sewer force main and one air release valve manhole was installed this week. Representatives from the City of Brockton's landfill subconsultant (CEC) were on-site to observe work in the landfill easement.
2. No work occurred on Monday 1/16 as a result of the heavy rain.
3. C. Naughton's crew is focusing on cleanup/restoration of the cross-country easement through the landfill on Friday 1/20. The crew will remove their equipment and demobilize from the easement in advance of moving over to Auburn Street in Whitman next week.
4. All areas were backfilled and compacted prior to leaving for the weekend.

WEEK LOOK-AHEAD SCHEDULE:

1. C. Naughton will have one crew on-site on Tuesday 1/24 (week of 1/23/2023) on Auburn Street in Whitman to continue installing air release valve and blow-off/cleanout fittings in the access manholes along the force main alignment. No work is scheduled to occur on Monday 1/23.
2. C. Naughton anticipates maintaining one lane of alternating traffic on Auburn Street while work is on-going. Access for local residents and for emergency vehicles will be maintained while work is on-going.
3. Daily traffic updates to the Town's project website will be posted to alert residents of any planned roadway closures and detours.
